APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 82626, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 82626 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 13959; Certificate 5437; Permit 14458, Certificate 5438; Permit 68981 and Permit 85460 shall not exceed 1,525.5 acre-feet annually.

If any water under this permit is cancelled or any water is not put to beneficial use, it will revert to the groundwater source and not back to the base water right.

This permit is issued for irrigation purposes within the described place of use, further identified as Nye County Assessor's Parcel Numbers 035-041-69, 70, 71 and 036-031-39.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 0.67 cubic feet per second or 183.0 acre-feet annually but not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 27 2017

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:







Question 11, Proposed Works:

Existing Irrigation Well Number 1

The well was drilled in 1948 to a dept of 445 feet with a 16" casing to 273 feet deep (Please see Well Log 738). In 1951, the well was deepened to 620 feet with a 12" casing from 240 feet to 620 feet (Please see Well Log 1829). In 1960, the well was deepened to 825 feet and utilizes a 10" ID casing from 165 feet to 825 feet deep (Please see Well Log 5553).

The Well is equipped with a 100 HP US Motor Serial Number 1310759 and a Worthington Pump Serial Number 1000166.

The Well is equipped with a 10" McCrometer totalizing flowmeter, Serial # 05 11197. The meter reading on August 25, 2015 was 374,486,000.

Question #16, Miscellaneous Remarks:

This application is being submitted as a change of the point of diversion only for Application 82626, which is a change of Permit 21984, Certificate 7288.

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
