APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 56658, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 56658 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The well must be sealed from ground level to 100 feet in accordance with NAC 534.380.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.





The water under this application will be used to supply potable water for two (2) single family residences and one office/shop building which includes a bunkhouse with kitchenette and bathroom. The existing QM system is from a spring source that earlier this year has notice greatly reduced flows which has been causing the pumps to break suction and has been damaging the pumps. Also, the Department has had marginal success with the disinfection system and the water regularly tests positive for total coliforms.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

The existing QM system will be maintained for Fire suppression and as a backup supply should the well need to be down for maintenance or repairs. A permanent change application will be submitted once the map is complete.
