APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 68030, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 26349, Certificate 8050, which changed the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of Claim 615, Truckee River Decree, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This permit is subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and State Engineer.

This permit abrogates 240.0 acre-feet annually from the base right, as requested. However, pursuant to NRS 533.3703, only the net consumptive use amount being, 150.0 acre-feet as decreed can be diverted.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 2.25 cubic feet per second or 150.0 acre-feet as decreed.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: Filed Under 82371 on April 25, 2014

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: January 13 2019



Permit No. 68030, being a portion of the water heretofore appropriated under Claim No. 615, Truckee River Decree.

5. The water is to be diverted at the following point (Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a found section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.)

There will be no diversion. The water is to remain in the stream channel of the Truckee River from an existing, permitted point of diversion (Steamboat Canal) to the inlet of Pyramid Lake. NE1/4 SW1/4, Sec. 31, T19N, R18E, MDB&M, or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 31 bears S. 62° 04' E. a distance of 3195 ft. (see Exhibit A)

6. The existing point of diversion is located within (If point of diversion is not changed, do not answer.)

The points of diversion of Truckee Meadow Water Authority's existing Water Treatment Plants as described in Exhibit "A" attached to Permit No. 68030 and as shown on the map supporting Permit No. 58882 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources.

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7. Proposed place of use (Describe by legal subdivisions. If for irrigation, state number of acres to be irrigated.)

The proposed place of use is the Truckee River stream channel downstream to the Pyramid Lake inlet as shown on the map accompanying Application No. 67182.

The existing places of use are as described in Exhibit "B" attached to Permit No. 68030 and shown on the map supporting Application No. 62141 on file with the State of Nevada, Division of Water Resources.



There are multiple (six) permitted points of diversion associated with the base water rights being changed by this application. This application identifies one of the permitted points of diversion (Steamboat Canal) for the proposed point of diversion. However, there will be no diversion of water. The water is to remain in the Truckee River stream channel from the Steamboat Canal to the Pyramid Lake, for wildlife, including instream flows for fish (cui-ui and Lahontan cutthroat trout).
