APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 50387, Certificate 13954, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 50387, Certificate 13954 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 50387, Certificate 13954; Permit 50876, Certificate 13281; Permit 50878, Certificate 13282; Permit 50879, Certificate 13283; Permit 50881, Certificate 13284; Permit 50882, Certificate 13285; Permit 50883, Certificate 13286; Permit 50885, Certificate 13287; Permit 50886, Certificate 13288; Permit 50887, Certificate 13289; Permit 51284, Certificate 13291; and Permit 51772, Certificate 13294; and Permits 84542T and 85526T shall not exceed 816.03 acre-feet.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.




