APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 50683, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 50683 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The well under Permit 19093, Certificate 6656 is supplemental to Permit 50683 and may not be pumped except for domestic purposes upon issuance of this Temporary Permit 85532T.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.





This Temporary Application will replace Temporary Permit 84240-T, and will be expired by the permitting of pending Applications to Change 84241 and 84242, currently Ready for Action. The total combined duty under this Application, Application 84241 to Change Permit 50683 and Application 84242 to Change Permit 19093, Certificate 6656 shall not exceed 124 million gallons annually (380.54 AFA).
