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**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 84168, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 84168 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. The State retains the right to regulate the use of water herein granted at any and all times.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **not to exceed 0.11 cubic feet per second and 18.0 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle, 10 head of horses and 100 head of sheep.**



Existing wells will be equipped with motor, pump and connected to an existing underground manifold and piping system capable of delivering stock water to multiple locations through out the boundaries of the ranch properties described under Item No. 7 during periods of time when freezing is not anticipated. During freezing periods, stock water will be provided near the point of diversion.
