**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of water begins, or before the proof of completion of work is filed. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, not to exceed 0.026 cubic feet per second and 18.0 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle, 10 horses and 100 sheep.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before: Filed Under 84168 on June 10, 2016


Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before: October 26 2019

Granite Peak Properties, L.C. is a Nevada domestic limited liability company filed with the Nevada Secretary of State on July 15, 1996

Existing wells will be equipped with motor, pump and connected to an existing underground manifold and piping system capable of delivering stock water to multiple locations through out the boundaries of the ranch properties described under Item No. 6 during periods of time when freezing is not anticipated. During freezing periods, stock water will be provided near the point of diversion.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

Stock water appropriations are being requested for Wells 18, 16 and 6. A total of 800 cattle, 10 horses and 100 sheep will be utilizing water within the proposed place of use. The total combined duty of these three wells is 18.0 acre feet per year.
