APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 18092, Certificate 5189, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 18092, Certificate 5189, and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The well must be sealed from ground level to 100 feet in accordance with NAC 534.380.

This permit is also issued subject to the provision that the place of use of the water herein granted is limited to and supplemental to lands having existing water rights, as decreed under Truckee River Claims 76/76A and 718, of the Orr Ditch Decree.

This permit is limited to the irrigation of 1.50 acres within the proposed place of use.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.0375 cubic feet per second or 6.0 acre-feet annually and not to exceed a duty of 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

March 29 2018

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:

March 29 2021

Map in support of proof of beneficial use shall be filed on or before:



1.50 acres to be irrigated within portions of the NW1/4 SW1/4, NE1/4 SW1/4, SW1/4 SW1/4, and the SE1/4 SW1/4 in Section 7, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.M. Refer to Washoe County Assessor's Parcel No. 162-252-03. The exact location to be determined upon proof of beneficial use. Refer to map filed in support of this application.

8. Existing place of use (Describe by legal subdivisions. If changing place of use and/or manner of use of irrigation permit, describe acreage to be removed from irrigation.)

1.50 acres will be removed from irrigation within S1/2 NW1/4 SW1/4 NE1/4 Section 27, T. 20N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. Refer to map filed in support of Permit No. 18092, Certificate 5189.

9. Proposed use will be from January 1 to December 31 of each year.

The well under this application is proposed to be drilled within the next year. The proposed point of diversion will be separate from service to the domestic dwelling and will include installation of a back-flow preventer based on discussion with Truckee Meadows Water Authority. This application is being filed to allow the applicant to irrigate landscaping and turf areas throughout the proposed place of use. Permit No. 18092, Certificate 5189 is a primary stand-alone irrigation right, and irrigation within the proposed place of use shall not exceed a duty of 4.0 acre-feet annually from all sources.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Permit No. 18092, Certificate 5189, is being abrogated by the Burke Family Trust Agreement under multiple applications for the full certificated 20 acres.
