
The water source is known as Cherry Spring and is located within the Dixie Valley Grazing Allotment (#0318). The applicant is the owner the BLM grazing lease in which this spring is located. The BLM recognizes the applicant and the spring as an improvement to the allotment.

13. Miscellaneous remarks:

Permit 7977 Certificate 2725 appropriates water from the same source. State records show ownership of that permit as Michael A. & Claudia C. Casey. However, the owner of that record does not own the grazing lease and/or the Dixie Valley Allotment in which the water is tied to. Moreover this spring is within the boundaries of the Dixie Valley Grazing Allotment and not within the Clan Alpine Allotment.
