APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 77448, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 77448 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis within 30 days after the end of each calendar year.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 73204, 77447, 77448, 77449, 79705, 79706, 79707, 80797, 80799, 81229, 81230, 81612, 81653, 83501, 83502, 83503, 83504, 83505, 83506, 83507 and 85644T shall not exceed 2,111.25 acre-feet annually. However, initially only the net consumptive use amount of 1,944.4 acre-feet can be used. Additional diversion up to the total 2,111.25 acre-feet may be granted if it can be shown that the additional diversion will not cause the consumptive use of 1,944.4 acre-feet to be exceeded.

The manner of use of water under this temporary permit is by nature of its activity a temporary use and any application to change the manner of use granted under this temporary permit will be subject to additional determination and evaluation with respect to the permanent effects on existing rights and the resource within the groundwater basin.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 1.527 cubic feet per second or 362.8 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:




