
This application is being filed to support native re-vegetation activities within the proposed place of use. Water from this underground source will be used to supplement Walker River Storage Rights, in accordance with the terms of the permit. An expanded period of use is proposed under this application, with Wyoming Big Sage and Four Wing Salt Bush being planted in the fall, and requiring early spring irrigation. Drip irrigation used for re-vegetation will use significantly less water than conventional farming. Re-vegetation activities are anticipated to continue through 2016; use of supplemental groundwater is contingent upon available surface water at key points throughout the irrigation season.
