APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 40307, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 40307 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 9966, Certificate 2798; Permit 18742, Certificate 5252; Permit 18743, Certificate 5253; Permit 24652, Certificate 8175; Permit 25530, Certificate 8181; Permit 35834, Certificate 14267; Permit 36155, Certificate 10907; Permit 36156, Certificate 10908; Permit 36157, Certificate 10909; Permits 40307, 61213, 64512, 65699 and 85719 shall not exceed 9,406.97 acre-feet annually.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, and not to exceed 3.772 cubic feet per second or 2,730.81 acre-feet annually.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

April 20, 2018

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




