**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued subject to all existing rights on the source. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance and that the final water right obtained under this permit will be dependent upon the period of use and the average number of livestock served from the waters of this source. It is further understood that this right must allow for a reasonable lowering of the static water level at permittee's well due to any other ground water development in the area. The well shall be equipped with a 2-inch opening for measuring depth to water. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The well must be sealed from ground level to 100 feet in accordance with NAC 534.380.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 35063, Certificate 12060; Permit 65566, Certificate 15873; and Permits 85425, 85724, 85725, 85726, 85727 and 85729 shall not exceed 26.88 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 1,200 head of cattle.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, not to exceed 0.0371 cubic feet per second and 26.88 acre-feet annually, or sufficient to water 1,200 head of cattle.

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

January 30 2018

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:




