APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This permit, is to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 24696, Certificate 8284, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 24696, Certificate 8284 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The well must be sealed from ground level to 100 feet in accordance with NAC 534.380.

This permit, for underground water, is fully supplemental to lands having decreed surface water. The underground water is to be used to the extent that this surface water is not available. The permit holder is responsible for insuring delivery of the surface water to those lands within the place of use irrigated by Decreed Carson River Claims 125, 126 and 127. The total diversion of water from this supplemental permit shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre, and is limited to the extent necessary to make up a portion of 4.0 acre-feet per acre when combined with the entitled decree during any given year. In the event that 4.0 acre-feet per acre is delivered from surface sources, then this supplemental underground right shall not be pumped.

This permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.161 cubic feet per second or 40.0 acre-feet annually, but is limited to 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 8 2017

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:





From the well, lateral above and below ground pipes will convey the water to a sprinkler array to irrigate pastures within APN 1420-32-002-018 in Douglas County, Nevada.
