APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit to change the place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Permit 67449 which changed the place and manner of use of a portion of Claim No. 3, Truckee River Decree is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said decree and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A suitable measuring device must be installed and accurate measurements of water placed to beneficial use must be kept.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire November 15, 2016, at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is expressly contingent on the payment of the operation and maintenance charges that are properly assessed and come due in the same manner as if the water were still appurtenant to the agricultural land from which it is transferred, pursuant to NRS 533.370, subsection 1 (b).

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.





The use of City of Fernley's water for re-vegetation & dust control purposes arises out of an inter-local agreement dated July 11, 2007 between Churchill County and City of Fernley resolving and withdrawing Churchill's protest of Fernley's applications seeking to change the POU from land in Churchill County.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Re-vegetation Efforts will be coordinated with the Lahontan Natural Resource Conservation District. Refer to similar permit 79672T issued for the 2010 irrigation season, 80823T for 2011, 81598T for 2012, 82645T/82818T for 2013, 82645T for the 2014 irrigation season, and 84874T for the 2015 irrigation season.
