APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 36159, Certificate 12216, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 36159, Certificate 12216 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 85991T, 85992T, and 85993T shall not exceed 460.0 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 115.0 acres.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.499 cubic feet per second or 119.19 acre-feet annually, but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**





This application is being filed to allow the applicant develop a new 115 acre pivot located White Pine County APN 008-480-14. Portions of Permit Nos. 22373, Cert. 7714, 36159, Cert. 12216, and 84615 are being changed to allow for irrigation at 4.0 acre-feet per acre. Permit No. 36159 was certificated for a duty of 3.0 acre-feet per acre, which required this volume to be converted to a greater duty. Permanent applications are intended to follow these temporary filings after a discussion of the preferred duty in the area. The applicant wishes to develop two similar pivots, but intends to purchase necessary infrastructure incrementally, based on State Engineer's approval of applications.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Refer to Permit Nos. 47250 and 47251 for additional information; these water rights have been cancelled, but were initially approved for irrigation for a total of 320 acres, half of this acreage within the proposed place of use.


