APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 61754, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 61754 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer within 45 days from the expiration of this temporary permit.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 86055T and 86056T shall not exceed 600 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.





Water under this application will be used in accordance with a contract between CC Construction and Boulder Solar Project, LLC, to perform several work items listed herein but not limited to the following: all clearing and grubbing, access road construction and maintenance, site preparation (including cut & fill dirt work to engineered grades) for the solar arrays, site drainage, and dust control as necessary to comply with Clark County and Boulder City requirements. Attached is the overall site plan for the solar field. A temporary change application of the corresponding supplemental portion of water under Permit 61754 is being filed in conjunction with this application.
