APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 53742, Certificate 13434, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 53742, Certificate 13434 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The well must be sealed from ground level to 100 feet in accordance with NAC 534.380.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit is issued subject to the terms of the base right and with the understanding that the waters of this temporary permit are comingled with Humboldt River Proof DHR-00304; Permit 18868, Certificate 6770; Permit 34944, Certificate 12563; Temporary Permits 86135T, 86136T and 86137T; and that the seasonal duty shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources. Temporary Permit 86134T shall not exceed 296.22 acre-feet seasonally for the irrigation of 98.74 acres within the described place of use.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second or 296.22 acre-feet seasonally and is limited to 3.0 acre-feet per acre from all sources.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:






