The current place of use is not conducive to be irrigated by circular sprinkler, applicant proposes to change the place of use to an area that is better suited to irrigation by circular sprinkler. Applicant will use an existing irrigation well drilled under Permit 36796. Both the current place of use and the proposed place of use are also irrigated with surface water, the annual water usage will not exceed 3.6 acre feet from all sources.
