
Water has been stored in Squaw Valley Reservoir, released and then diverted from Squaw Valley Creek at the Dean Ditch. This application strips 125 acres from the existing place of use on the Clear Creek Ranch and moves it back up to the Squaw Creek Reservoir where it will be pumped out of the reservoir and then conveyed by a pipeline from the reservoir to a holding pond then run through pivots within the proposed place of use.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Application 84568 was filed in December 2014 and has been Ready for Action for over a year. This application is needed to allow for the irrigation of the proposed place of use during the upcoming irrigation season
