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**APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the place and manner of use of a portion the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 81375, Certificate 18805; is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 81375, Certificate 18805 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins or before the proof of completion of work is filed. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 81375, Certificate 18805, and Temporary Permit 86205T shall not exceed 351.80 acre-feet annually.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 76992, Certificate 19136; Permit 81375, Certificate 18805; Permit 81376, Certificate 18806; Permit 81377, Certificate 18807; Permit 81378, Certificate 19143; Permit 81379, Certificate 19144; Permit 81380, Certificate 18808; Permit 81381, Certificate 18809; Permit 81382, Certificate 18810; Permit 81383, Certificate 19945; Permit 81384, Certificate 19146; and Temporary Permit 86205T shall not exceed 609.985 acre-feet.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.


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
