2. The amount of water to be changed 0.03775 cfs (7.35 acre feet)
3. The water to be used for Irrigation and Domestic
4. The water heretofore used for Irrigation and Domestic
5. The water is to be diverted at the following point (Describe as being within a 40-acre subdivision of public survey and by course and distance to a found section corner. If on unsurveyed land, it should be stated.)

Build a diversion structure on Burnt Canyon Creek that allows full stream flow to pass when not using allocated water. Place a pipe in the stream channel to provide water to the users to the South in drought conditions.

Build a diversion structure on Burnt Canyon Creek to allow use of domestic and irrigation water for 2.35 acres. Also place a pipe in the stream channel to provide water to the users to the South.

16. Miscellaneous remarks:

Changing the location of diversion will make it possible to establish a crop and show beneficial use in drought conditions. The channel pipe could alleviate problems with the user to the South and possibly reduce the potential for alleged violations



2. Delmue Spring No. 2. SE^{1/4} SE^{1/4} Section 14, T.5N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 14 bears S. 41° 59' 14" E., a distance of 229.0 feet.
3. Delmue Spring No. 3. Lot 2, Section 19, T.5N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M., or at the point from which the W^{1/4} corner of said Section 19 bears S. 86° 06' 40" W., a distance of 817.7 feet.
4. Burnt Canyon Creek Diversion (Delmue) Dam No. 1. NE^{1/4} NW^{1/4} NW^{1/4} NE^{1/4} Section 24, T.5N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E^{1/4} corner of said Section 24 bears S. 57° 19' 56" E., a distance of 3,120.24 feet.
5. Burnt Canyon Creek Diversion (Delmue) Dam No. 2. NE^{1/4} NE^{1/4} Section 30, T.5N., R.70E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 30 bears N. 85° 24' 48" E., a distance of 692.65 feet.
