APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the place of use of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 52526, Certificate 13062, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 52526, Certificate 13062 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030.

The permittee shall keep monthly records of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on an annual basis by February 15th of each year.

The total combined duty of water under Permit 27860, Certificate 10018; Permit 30805, Certificate 11990; Permit 35884, Certificate 11387; Permit 35917, Certificate 11388; Permit 41196, Certificate 11414; Permit 52526, Certificate 13062; Permit 52527, Certificate 13063 and Permits 86272T, 86273T and 86274T shall not exceed 892.66 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire on May 1, 2017, at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.




