APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This environmental permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.4375, and provides for the completion of multiple extraction wells within the same quarter-quarter section, as long as the permitted amount is not exceeded. It is understood that the amount of water herein granted is only a temporary allowance for pollution control as mandated by orders issued by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection. The right will cease to exist upon termination of clean up activity, as determined by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, and the permittee shall notify the State Engineer within 30 days after the completion of the remediation project. All wells shall be plugged and abandoned in accordance with Chapter 534 of the Nevada Administrative Code. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline and monthly records of this measurement shall be submitted on an annual basis not later than February 15th of each year. If additional wells are drilled under this permit, a new mylar map showing the surveyed locations must be submitted with the annual report.

This permit is issued for environmental purposes within the described place of use, further identified as Clark County Assessor's Parcel Number 178-12-301-005.

This environmental permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this environmental permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

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The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second or 181 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:

September 30 2017

Water must be placed to beneficial use and proof of the application of water to beneficial use shall be filed on or before:


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
