APPROVAL OF STATE ENGINEER

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application, and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

This temporary permit, to change the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of the waters of an underground source as heretofore granted under Permit 54073, is issued subject to the terms and conditions imposed in said Permit 54073 and with the understanding that no other rights on the source will be affected by the change proposed herein. This well shall be equipped with a two (2) inch opening for measuring depth to water. A totalizing meter must be installed and maintained in the discharge pipeline near the point of diversion and accurate measurements must be kept of water placed to beneficial use. The totalizing meter must be installed before any use of the water begins. If the well is flowing, a valve must be installed and maintained to prevent waste. This source is located within an area designated by the State Engineer pursuant to NRS 534.030. The State retains the right to regulate the use of the water herein granted at any and all times.

Monthly records shall be kept of the amount of water pumped from this well and the records submitted to the State Engineer on a quarterly basis within 15 days after the end of each calendar quarter.

The total combined duty of water under Permits 54073, 54074 and 68822; Permit 74399, Certificate 17531; Permits 79001, 79002, 79003, 79004, 79005, 79006, 79007, 79008, 79009, 79010, 83490, 85856T, 85857T, 85858T, 85859T, 85860T, 85861T, 85862T, 85863T, 86466T, 86467T and 86468T shall not exceed 2,274.57 acre-feet annually.

This temporary permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of NRS 533.345 Section 2 and will expire 1 year after the approval of the permit at which time all rights herein granted shall revert to the right being changed by this temporary permit.

The place of use is limited to those basins identified in State Engineer's Ruling 6255, specifically identified as Coyote Spring Valley (210), Garnet Valley (216), Hidden Valley (217), California Wash (218), and Muddy River Springs Area (219) within Clark County, Nevada.

All provisions of the monitoring plan submitted to the State Engineer for approval under base right Permits 54073, 54074, and 68822, shall remain in force, and will apply to all subsequent change applications and new diversion-only appropriations. If information from the monitoring plan or other studies demonstrates an adverse impact on existing rights, mitigation will be required to the satisfaction of the State Engineer.

This temporary permit does not extend the permittee the right of ingress and egress on public, private or corporate lands.

The issuance of this temporary permit does not waive the requirements that the permit holder obtain other permits from State, Federal and local agencies.

The point of diversion and place of use are as described on the submitted application to support this permit.

The amount of water to be appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use, **and not to exceed 0.344 cubic feet per second or 150.21 acre-feet annually.**

Work must be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and proof of completion of work shall be filed on or before:




