The current point of diversion under Permit No. 21236, Certificate 6810 (Referred to as the Corral Well/Well No. 1) no longer has consistent diversion to support pivot irrigation within the proposed place of use. This application proposes to move this water to an existing production well and will be utilized to irrigate existing fields in production. The existing point of diversion is still intended to be used to support domestic/culinary needs on the ranch.
