Description of use other than irrigation. Water is conducted through 80 feet of one  
inch pipe, to a galvanized iron trough, 12 feet long x 31 inches  
wide x 16 inches deep, and there used for watering stock.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to stock watering purposes.

\_\_\_\_\_ and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the  
purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for  
which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water  
appropriated.
