through the ditch, pipe-line, flume ( ) for  
irrigation, power, stock ( ) and domestic purposes, the point of diversion named in said  
application being as follows: At the springs near the Section Line, in the  
Northern portion of the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Sec. 14 T. 36 N. R. 47 E., M. D. B. & M.

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of  
1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

Description of irrigated land

Description of use other than irrigation. Water from East Spring is conducted through  
a 2 inch galvanized iron pipe, 16 feet long, to a wooden trough 16 feet  
long, 18 inches deep and 18 inches wide. Water from West Spring is con-  
ducted through 16 feet of 1 inch galvanized iron pipe to a wooden trough  
16 feet long, 10 inches deep and 12 inches wide.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to Watering Livestock.

and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the  
purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for  
which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water  
appropriated.
