WHEREAS, Thomas Dixon has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

application being as follows: At the spring, located South 85° 09' West, 14407 feet from the S.W. Corner of Section 18, T. 16 N.R. 56 E., M.D.B & M.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

Description of irrigated land

Description of use other than irrigation Water is diverted at the spring and conducted through the 50 foot pipe-line (Hillside Pipe-line) to watering tank, and there used for watering Livestock.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to Watering Livestock.

and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water appropriated.
