CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank Bassett has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

SAND SPRING

through the Bassett reservoir ditch, pipe-line, flume ( ) for irrigation, power, stock ( Stockwatering ) and domestic purposes, the point of diversion named in said

application being as follows: Sand spring lies N. 15°3' E. 106,875 feet from the corner of section 9-10-15 & 16 of T. 20 N.R. 66 E., M.D.B & M. The reservoir lies S. 11° E. 563 feet from the spring.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

Date of appropriation May 8th, 1908.

Description of irrigated land None.

Note: The reservoir in which the water is impounded lies S. 11°E. 563 feet from the spring. The reservoir is in the natural channel of the stream leading from the spring. The stock of the applicant water directly from the reservoir.

Description of use other than irrigation Watering stock and Domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to Watering stock and domestic purposes.

and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water appropriated.
