

CORRECTED CERTIFICATE**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, T. F. Norton for Bednark and Norton, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cordwood Creek, Whiteman Creek and Whiteman Spring, through ditches for irrigation, stockwater and domestic purposes. The points of diversion of water from the sources are as follows:

At points on Cordwood Creek, Whiteman Creek and Whiteman Spring from which the SE corner of Section 36, T.22N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M., bears respectively, S. 30°23' W., 5,934.1 feet distant; S. 68°28' W., 536 feet distant; and S. 4°28' E., 2,213.2 feet distant, situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Irrigation, Stockwater and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.262 c.f.s., but not to exceed 78.6 acre-feet per season.

Date of priority of appropriation:	May 2, 1908

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is diverted from Cordwood Creek, Whiteman Creek and Whiteman Spring, through diversion structures and ditches for flood irrigation of the following land:

10.42 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T.22N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M.
7.92 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T.22N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M.
1.11 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T.22N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M.
2.18 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T.22N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M.
3.44 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T.22N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M.
1.13 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 36, T.22N., R.64E., M.D.B.&M.
26.2 acres total

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total seasonal duty of water shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.

Description of irrigated land 3.44 acres grain in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4; 1.11 acres grain, 0.78 acres alfalfa, and 0.29 acres garden in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4; 1.13 acres alfalfa in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4; 1.11 acres alfalfa in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4; 2.73 acres alfalfa, 0.17 acres garden, and 5.02 acres meadow in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4; 8.75 acres pasture and 1.67 acres garden in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4; making a total of 26.2 acres all in T 22 N. R 64 E. M.D.B. & M. This land is irrigated by the combined flow of the three sources herein named.

Description of use other than irrigation -----

Stockwatering and domestic purposes

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the period between Apr. 1st and Oct. 1st of each year for irrigation and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water appropriated.
