

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Emmet D. Boyle, for the Pacific Portland Cement Company, Consolidated, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

through ~~the~~ -----a----- ditch, pipe-line, ~~flume~~ (-----) for ~~irrigation, power, stock~~ (-----mining-----) and domestic purposes, the point of diversion named in said application being as follows: at the spring which is N. 47°--55'E. 1530 feet from the NW cor. of sec. 24, T. 16 N. R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., as shown by map filed under the application, situated in -----Lyon----- County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

Name of appropriator Pacific Portland Cement Company, Consolidated.

Amount of appropriation .02 (2/100) cubic feet per second.

Date of appropriation ----July 15, 1912.

Description of irrigated-land works:-

The works consist of a 50-gallon barrel at the spring from which water is conducted to the place of use by means of a pipe-line as follows: 2208 feet of 2 in. pipe and 8692 feet of 1 in. pipe in main line to mill and quarry, and 2700 feet of 1 in. pipe in branch line to quarry. The difference in elevation in the termini of the main pipe-line is- 1208 feet.

Description of use ~~other than irrigation~~ The water is used to supplement a supply ~~used~~ from Wiggins Spring, at the mill, quarry, boarding houses and Cottages of the appropriator. -----

The right to water hereby determined is limited to for all times of the year that it can be beneficially used, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water appropriated.
