

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C.R. STARKWEATHER has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Six Mile Spring through the by means of ditch, pipe-line, flume (irrigation, power, stock) and domestic purposes, the point of diversion named in said application being as follows: At a reservoir in the channel which is N. 42 - 30' E., 26796 feet from the corner of townships 16 & 17 N. R. 67 & 68 E., M. D. B. & M., situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

 Amount of appropriation .01 (1/100) cubic foot per second.
 Date of appropriation June 15, 1910.

Description of irrigated land works:-

Water is diverted from Six Mile Spring through a channel or ditch to the reservoir located as above described. The Spring is located N. 80 - 0'E., 4950 ft. from the reservoir.

Option of use other than irrigation:-

Stock watering and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to such times of the year as it can be beneficially used, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water appropriated.
