

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J.W. SNOW for the OHANA MINING COMPANY has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use; from -----

 survey were extended. -----, situated in WHITE FINE ----- County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

 Amount of appropriation ----- Two (2) cubic feet per second. -----  
 Date of appropriation ----- March 6th., 1911. -----

Description of irrigated land works:-

Water is diverted from the spring through a ten-inch wood  
 stave pipe approximately 6900 feet long to the Ohana Mining  
 Company's mill where it is used for the purposes named above.  
 The mill is located in what would be the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 18,  
 T. 15 N. R. 68 E., M. D. B. & M., if public survey were extended.

Description of use other than irrigation:-

Power, milling and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to such times of the year as it can  
 be beneficially used -----, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the  
 purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for  
 which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water  
 appropriated.
