CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W.N. McGill for the Adams-McGill Co., Inc. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

White Rock Spring

through the by means of a pipe-line ditch, pipe-line, flume () for irrigation, power, stock () and domestic purposes, the point of diversion named in said

application being as follows: at S. 86°-50'W., 7460 feet from the NE Cor. of Sec. 3, T. 1 S. R. 62 E., M. D. B. & M., on unsurveyed land.

Carlin, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

Amount of appropriation .025 (1/40) cubic foot per second.
Date of appropriation November 10th., 1913.

Description of irrigated land works: -

Water is diverted from the spring through a pipe-line 4500 feet long to a concrete reservoir 12 feet by 12 feet by 2 feet deep. The pipe-line varies in size from a 2 inch pipe at the head to a 1/2 inch pipe at the end. The concrete reservoir is located at S. 54°-40'W., 4470 feet from the NE Cor. of Sec. 3, T. 1 S. R. 62 E., M. D. B. & M.

Description of use other than irrigation: -

Stock watering and domestic purposes

The right to water hereby determined is limited to such times of the year as it can be beneficially used, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water appropriated.
