CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert A. Baroni for D. Baroni and Company, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Carson River through the Baroni ditch and Peter Quilici & Co's ditch, pipe-line, flume for irrigation, power, stock and domestic purposes, the point of diversion named in said application being as follows: on the East side of the Carson River at N. 59° 28' W., 1404 feet from the Northeast corner of Sec. 26, T. 16 N. R.

21 E., M. D. B. & M. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

Name of appropriator D. Baroni and Company.

Postoffice address Dayton, Lyon County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 303 acre feet per annum, with the privilege granted of using the rotation system of irrigation.

Date of appropriation: Original dates: 1863, 1876, 1895 & 1904 as shown below opposite the various areas of land.

Description of irrigated land in T. 16 N. R. 21 E., M. D. B. & M. as follows:

Table with 4 columns: Area (acres), Description, Date of Appropriation, and Total. Rows include specific land parcels like '19.0 acres, -- South part of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4, Sec. 13, 1863' and a final '101.0 acres, ---- Total' row.

Description of use other than irrigation: Stock watering and domestic purposes.

Note:- This certificate is granted for a change in the point of diversion of the ditch to serve the land as listed above. Date of the application to change point of diversion is Dec. 27th., 1913

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the period between April 1st. and Oct. 1st. of each year, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water appropriated.
