CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Geo. W. Byers. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Herer (Herder) Creek through the Byers ditch, pipeline flume for irrigation, power, stock and domestic purposes, the point of diversion named in said application being as follows: within the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 10, T 36 N. R 60 E, M.D.B. & M., at S. 87° 54' W., 1667 ft. from the NE corner of the said Sec. 10, situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

Description of use other than irrigation

Stockwatering and domestic purposes

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the period between Apr. 1st. and Sept. 1st. of each year, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water appropriated.
