CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles Eaton has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

----- Springs in Silver Park Gulch -----

through the Silver Park ditch, pipe-line, flume (-----) for

irrigation, power, stock (mining, milling) and domestic purposes, the point of diversion named in said

application being as follows: on unsurveyed ground at S. 34° - 20' W., 4170 feet

from the U.S. Mineral Monument No. 1, in Silver Park Mining

District, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 29, Chapter XVIII, Statutes of 1907, has determined the amount of such appropriation as follows:

Name of appropriator Charles Eaton.

Postoffice address Atlanta, Lincoln Co., Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.75 (3/4) cubic foot per second.

Date of appropriation November 23rd, 1911.

Description of irrigated land works;- Water rises to the surface on a marshy piece of ground some three or four acres in extent. It is collected by four trenches, some of which are four feet deep, and is conveyed to a common point; thence the combined flow is taken by ditch to the place of use on unsurveyed ground at S. 1° - 28' E., 1522 feet from the U.S. Mineral Monument No. 1 in Silver Park Mining District.

Description of use other than irrigation The water is used for mining, milling and domestic purposes at the point above described.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to such times of the year as it can be beneficially used, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired; rights for irrigation not to exceed three acre-feet per year for each acre of land for which appropriation is herein determined. Continued title to water depends upon beneficial use of water appropriated.
