CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Paul D. McMillen has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from McMillen Spring through McMillen Ditch for irrigation and domestic purposes and domestic purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source being N.W. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4, Sec. 29, T. 44 N. R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Paul D. McMillen

Postoffice address Vya, Washoe County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.05 cubic foot per second

Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year for irrigation and all the year for domestic purposes.

Date of priority of appropriation May 3rd, 1911

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows: 5 acres in N.E. 1/4 of NW 1/4, Sec. 29, T. 44 N. R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
