CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C.W. Love for the Gardner Ranch Company has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Willow Spring

through an open cut and pipe line for stock-watering and domestic

purposes, The point of diversion of water from the source ^{being} as follows: within what would be the SW¹/₄ or SW¹/₄ Sec. 25, T. 4 S. R. 61 E., M. D. B. & M. if the land were surveyed, situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Gardner Ranch Company.

Postoffice address Salt Lake City, Utah.

Amount of appropriation .025 (1/40) cubic foot per second.

Period of use, from Jan. 1st, to Dec. 31st, of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 19th, 1916.

Description of ~~original~~ ~~land~~ ~~with~~ ~~water~~ ~~appurtenant~~ ~~to~~ ~~the~~ ~~works~~: - Water is conveyed from the spring through an open cut 4 feet deep by 30 feet long to a trough 1 foot wide by 1 foot deep by 12 feet long; thence through a pipe line 1 1/2 inches in diameter and 300 feet long to a cement tank 2 feet deep by 8 feet wide by 8 feet long.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
