CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, the Humphrey-Reed Land and Cattle Company, a corporation, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Red Bluff Springs through by means of a pipe line for stock-watering and domestic purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source being S. 63°-30' E., 15840 feet from the SE Cor. of T. 3 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Humphrey-Reed Land and Cattle Company, a corporation.
Postoffice address Tonopah, Nye County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.0125 (1/80) cubic foot per second.
Period of use, from January 1st. to December 31st. of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 5th., 1914.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows: WORKS: - - - - -

Water is diverted by means of a short pipe line 1 1/2 inches in diameter to troughs installed in the natural channel just below the springs where the small flow is conserved for the watering of stock.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
