CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, the Adams-McGill Co. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from -----South Well in Cherry Creek Valley----- through pumps and troughs for stock watering and domestic purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source being as follows: at S. 34°-20' W., 69350 feet from the NE corner, Sec. 6, T. 5 N. R. 60 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Adams-McGill Co., a corporation.

Postoffice address Ely, White Pine County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.0062 cubic foot per second, or about 2000 gallons in 12 hours.

Period of use, from January 1st. to December 31st. of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 16th., 1914.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows: WORKS:

The well is 4 feet square and 33 feet deep. Water is raised by means of a triplex pump operated by horse power, and is conveyed to watering troughs through a short 2 inch pipe. The dimensions of troughs are 12 inches wide by 12 inches deep and the total length of the troughs is 220 feet. They are made of lumber.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
