CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John David Weeks has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Steel or Brassy Creek through Weeks Ditches for irrigation and domestic purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source being as follows: points within the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4, Sec. 11 and SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 12, in T. 35 N.R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.667 cubic foot per second.
Period of use, from April 15th, to June 1st, of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 23rd, 1911.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
