CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ernest C. Wood has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Johnson Creek through small sloughs used as ditch lines for irrigation and domestic purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source being as follows: Within the E 1/2 of NE 1/4, Sec. 30, Tp. 35 N. R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915; has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator E. C. Wood,
Postoffice address Wells, Elko Co., Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 2.164 cubic feet per second.
Period of use, from May 1st to July 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 24th, 1910.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

Table with 4 columns: Acres, Section, Township, Range. Rows include 68.7 acres in NW 1/4 of Sec. 28, 91.3 acres in NE 1/4, 13.0 acres in SW 1/4, 43.4 acres in SE 1/4, and a TOTAL of 216.4 Acres.

Permit No. 1854, under which this certificate is issued, was granted for the waste waters of Johnson Creek which reach the N 1/2 of Sec. 30, T. 35 N., R. 62 E.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified; and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
