CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Silverino Penelas for

WHEREAS, J. P. Buzanes and Silverino Penelas has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Springs, three in number through a small ditch for irrigation and domestic purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: from Willow Springs which bears S. 59° W. 50,212.8 feet from corner common to sections 17, 18, 19 and 20 T. 16 N. R. 40 E. M.D.B. & M. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

- Name of appropriator J.P. Buzanes and Silverino Penelas.
Postoffice address Ione, Nye County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.10 (1/10) of a cubic foot per second.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 23rd, 1910.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows: About 9 acres contiguous to above described springs on unsurveyed land; but which if the public land surveys were extended, would probably lie in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 11, T. 15 N., R. 38 E. M.D.B. & M. This land is situated about 1 1/2 miles northerly from Phonolite, Nye County, Nevada.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
