CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, O. O. Tognini, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow (or Summit) Spring through an unnamed pipe-line for stock and domestic purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source being in NE 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 32 T. 24 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator O. O. Tognini.
Postoffice address Hobson, White Pine County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation .01 (1/100) cubic foot per second.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 8th, 1914.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows: Works:
Water is conducted from spring through 50 feet of pipe to two troughs.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
