

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Reuben S. Boyle has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Nigger Creek through an unnamed canal for irrigation purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 14, T. 35 N., R. 23 E. M.D.B. & M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Period of use, from April 1st to November 1st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation April 14th, 1911

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

- 18.20 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 25, T. 35 N., R. 23 E. M.D.B. & M.
- 18.20 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 25, T. 35 N., R. 23 E. M.D.B. & M.
- 3.86 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 25, T. 35 N., R. 23 E. M.D.B. & M.
- 3.86 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 25, T. 35 N., R. 23 E. M.D.B. & M.
- 44.12 acres Total.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
