CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Tony Marteletti has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Boulder Creek through an unnamed ditch for irrigation purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source being as follows: on unsurveyed land in T. 9 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M. whence U.S. Mineral Monument "Morey" bears N. 10° 44' W. 12,998 feet. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Tony Marteletti.
Postoffice address Duckwater, Nye County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation .15 (15/100) cubic foot per second.
Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 26, 1914.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:
15 acres in T. 9 N., R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M. on unsurveyed land and the NW corner of said 15 acres bears N., 85° E., 6001 feet from the above described point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
