CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. G. Adamson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Eldorado Canon Creek, through an unnamed pipe-line for power, milling and domestic purposes, the point of diversion of water from the source being as follows: bears from C. C. of Sections 30 and 31, T. 31 N., R. 34 E. M.D.B. & M. S. 26° 45' W. 2490 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator W. G. Adamson.
Postoffice address Winnemucca, Humboldt County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 1.002 cubic foot per second.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 20, 1913.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows: works:
Water is diverted through a four inch pipe line 550 feet in length to the point of use, for domestic purposes and the cooling of furnaces and retorts in the reduction of ores.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
