

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. C. Turner has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from West Walker River through Simpson Colony Reclamation Canal for Irrigation and Domestic use, being purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 10, T. 10, N., R. 23, E., M. D. B. & M. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Chapter 253, Statutes of 1915, has determined the date, source, purpose, and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator C. C. TURNER.
Postoffice address Wellington, Lyon County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation .3518 cubic feet per second.
Period of use, from April 1st to October 1st. of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 5th, 1912.

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant is as follows:

- 10.52 acres NE 1/4 of Section 3, T. 10 N., R. 23 E., M. D. B. & M.
- 6.31 acres SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M. D. B. & M.
- 18.35 acres NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 11 N., R. 23 E., M. D. B. & M.
- 35.18 acres Total.

This appropriation is exclusive of the .5 cubic feet per second, granted under the Thurtell Findings, as avested right; although the water under both grants will be diverted jointly, from the same source and at the same point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
